Jane Lead vs the NAR

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Other than the Introduction (#170) the following are not in any order of importance.

170) **JL vs NAR:** Discernment ministries have compared the teachings of the New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) to the writings of Jane Lead, even stating that they got their ideas from her.

When these studies began in May 2024, I had just learned that Christian researchers were attempting to link the aberrant teachings of the New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) with Jane Lead. Today an increasing number of “discernment ministers” are also naming Jane Lead as the source of NAR doctrines. This gross mistake stems from a failure of watchmen to do their own research. They read about Jane and her teachings from secular and Christian researchers—who themselves have drawn many incorrect conclusions. Even historical facts have been misrepresented.¹

It may not be a stretch to say that the average Christian caught up in the NAR has never heard of Jane Lead. They certainly don't hear about her from the pulpits. And it wouldn't be surprising if few, if any, NAR leaders have actually *studied* her writings. They may have read her [The 60 Propositions](#); but that's only an *outline* of her eschatology. Nevertheless her critics continue to associate the errant NAR doctrines with Jane Lead. To his credit a certain Christian researcher has indeed devoted a great deal of time studying her writings, though he, too, has drawn a number of incorrect conclusions.

The foundational tenet of the NAR that has been so successful in attracting Christians from every denominational and non-denominational Church is this: That the authoritative offices of apostles and prophets have been restored to the Church; and that they, as leaders of this unparalleled move of God, are uniquely qualified to receive the “new revelations” that are essential for establishing the Kingdom of God on Earth.² The phenomenal growth of this movement only further illustrates what has been declared often in these studies: That the absence of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers has rendered the Church unable to properly discern truth from error. It also shows how Christians are so spiritually immature that they must always follow a leader—and are even persuaded that this perpetually reliant state is totally acceptable to God.³

“Influenced” vs Plagiarized

The NAR leaders claim authority over all Christians, including pastors, in order to bring about the submission of the Church, and ultimately the world. So the question is whether the teachings of the NAR are in agreement with the teachings of Jane Lead. In order for Christian researchers, apologists, and discernment ministers to say that NAR leaders are “influenced” by Jane Lead, and are spreading *her* doctrines as *she* originally taught, they should offer verifiable proof—and in the proper context. But if her writings have been plagiarized and perverted, they should state that instead. And if the NAR has plagiarized and perverted Mrs. Lead, I will be bold to say that they have also perverted the teachings of the Lord Jesus Christ as the very *source* of the revelations that Jane received.

And so the question: Did they get their ideas from the writings of a gentle Englishwoman, who never sought or desired the role of a prophet, never promoted the advancement of a Christian society, never encouraged her followers toward any judicial punishment of the ungodly, who never said that the Kingdom would begin through any sort of *spiritual evolution*; and never said, “The kingdoms of this world are yours! Take them!” The NAR, Latter Rain (LR), Manifest Sons of God (MSOG) and Joel’s Army were not *influenced* by Jane Lead. For if they truly *believed* what she wrote, they would have followed that same *inward* path that she describes.

Rampant Words

Two words that are bandied about by discernment ministers with relation to Jane Lead are *heresy* and *blasphemy*: the very accusations made by the religious leaders that condemned our Lord and Savior.⁴ Heresy is a belief or teaching that *contradicts* established religious doctrine. Blasphemy is an act or expression of *irreverence* toward God. Heresy is a wrong *belief* (teaching), while blasphemy is an *insult* toward God. The letter-guardians are so hardened with *pride* over their knowledge of the *written* Word, that they have no *faith* in the *Spirit* of the Word as presented by Mrs. Lead.⁵ If a teaching does not agree with their *letter knowledge* of the Scriptures—they are quick to call it heretical and blasphemous. Such misuse of words by heartless Christians only demonstrates their own lack of understanding of the true nature of God.⁶ And a diligent researcher with any degree of integrity can only conclude that Jane Lead was neither heretical nor blasphemous against her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Not everything these ministers personally view as heresy is a false teaching. And not everything they personally consider blasphemy is an attack against the Almighty. So the major issue isn’t that the NAR continues to draw millions into deeper deception. The larger issue is that Christians worldwide are utterly *incapable* of discerning truth from error as the inevitable consequence of a system that has deprived the flock of the True Spirit of Christ. This tragedy of the absent Holy Spirit—as the most urgent need in the Church today—has already been covered in a number of places in these studies.⁷

The Mystery of Iniquity

The timing of the reception of the Holy Spirit has been an interpretational debate as far back as the first century. And it’s extremely significant that the Mystery of Iniquity was also present and active in the first century. Christian researchers, discernment ministers—and *all believers everywhere*—are urged to investigate for themselves exactly *how* and *why* the teaching that *all* Christians *automatically* receive the Holy Spirit *immediately* upon conversion to the faith became a popular and widely-accepted doctrine only in the last 100 years. And if the revealing of the Wicked One is withheld by the Holy Spirit, and is only to be *fully revealed* when the Holy Spirit is *taken out of the way*—it is clear that an absent Holy Spirit is not only the *reason* for the Apostasy, but is also *necessary* for the Apostasy—a mystery that is worthy of deep study and introspection.⁸

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. (2Th 2:7)

The word *iniquity* does not mean false or counterfeit. It means *lawless*.⁹ This mysterious lawlessness has been operating in the Church for 2,000 years. In denying the True Indwelling, the Church system has rejected the Law of the *Spirit of Life* in Christ Jesus—which is that alone that can set the soul free from the Law of Sin and Death!¹⁰ They have rejected the True Christ!

All Christians are to be Bereans; and all Bereans are to some degree theologians—perhaps not in a scholarly or professional sense—but theologians nevertheless. Paul’s instruction to Timothy and Titus was to raise *theologians*!¹¹ But knowledge of Scriptures alone isn’t what makes a Berean *noble*. It’s their willingness to *listen* to what is presented *with an open* heart and mind—and THEN see if it lines up with the Holy Scriptures.¹² But today’s discernment ministers immediately shut the doors of their minds to anything that runs against their preconceived understanding and call it heresy!¹³

It is both the responsibility and the moral duty of pastors and teachers in every denominational and non-denominational Church, and in every home fellowship, to properly lead and teach their charges, First: How to receive the Spirit of Christ, and Second: How to handle the Word of Truth. For the greater, fuller, and richer understanding of the Holy Scriptures is only attained through the reception, teaching, and guidance of the Promise of the Father! Yet the Church leaders do the one thing but not the other. They pump up the Word but not the reception of that alone which can properly interpret the Word. And a Christian can never become a fully equipped Berean, or live a victorious life over sin and deception without the Indwelling Spirit of the Resurrected Christ as a birth within the soul!

The true Berean must admit that the events leading up to the Lord's return are both vague and perplexing. Though the Book of Revelation describes end-time events, which of us *fully* understands that book, with so many differing and divisive interpretations? Yet God has given it for a reason. Can we not see that it is bursting with mysteries that are meant to be discovered? Daniel was a holy man who prayed fervently for understanding. But he was also heartbroken over the sad state of his people—and so he also prayed for the sins of his people!¹⁴ And the Lord *interrupted* his prayer, and gave the answer he was seeking. The Lord is ever willing to break open His vast treasury to a heart that is perfect toward Him.¹⁵ He longs to commune with the faith of Abraham, the obedience of Joseph, and the meekness of Moses.¹⁶ He is faithful to the heart of David, the reverence of Isaiah, and the passion of Paul.¹⁷ But let none think that God will reveal His intimate plans to the disobedient, the doubter, or the skeptic.¹⁸ Nor will He entrust them to the proud and arrogant letter-guardians.¹⁹ He reveals them to faithful souls that keep His commandments, and covet His will above all.²⁰

Questions to be Answered

This Q&A will not delve deeply into the NAR itself; which has already been well-covered and documented by Christian researchers and apologists [Holly Pivec](#) and [Doug Geivett](#).²¹ Instead the focus will be on what Jane Lead actually taught about the teachings that discernment ministries insist on associating with her. Topics will include: Adoption, Apostles and Prophets, Chosen Ones, Christian Perfection, Election, Joel's Army, Manifest Sons of God, Mass Elimination of the Ungodly, the New Creature, "Ongoing" Revelation, Second Pentecost, Sonship, Transfer of Wealth, etc. The following questions answered here briefly will be developed further in this Q&A:

1. Did Jane Lead teach the NAR Manifest Sons of God doctrine? No she did not.
2. Did she teach the NAR doctrine of a restoration (return) of apostles and prophets? No.
3. Did she teach the NAR doctrine of "ongoing" revelation? No.
4. Did she teach the NAR doctrine of a mass elimination of the ungodly by Christians? No.
5. Did she teach the NAR doctrine of a coming transfer of material wealth? No.
6. Did Jane Lead write of a coming Melchizedek Priesthood? Yes.
7. Did she identify the Melchizedek Priesthood as the 144,000 Firstborn of the Resurrection? Yes.
8. Did she refer to these Melchizedek Priests as "Elected" and "Chosen Ones?" Yes.
9. Did she provide information as to how these Priests are selected? Yes.
10. Did she write of the restoration (return) of the *Gifts* of Apostles and Prophets? Yes.
11. Did she teach about an Adoption? Yes.
12. Did she write of a coming war against evil? Yes.
13. Did she exhort Christians toward perfection? Yes.
14. Did she write of a "Second" Pentecost? Yes.
15. Did she teach that God's revelation of Himself is progressive? Yes.
16. Did she affirm the continuance of Divine Revelation? Yes.

The Coming Conversion

Christians eagerly proclaim “Thy Kingdom come.” But for many the Kingdom is the farthest thing from the heart. They proclaim a love for God, and a desire for His return, only to betray that claim by their love for the world, love of money and business, and love of comfort and pleasure. Therefore the Church’s great need is a *conversion* to *faith* in the coming Kingdom of God’s LOVE! Conversion is not a one-time event. It doesn’t begin when a soul finally realizes its need for the Savior; and it doesn’t end when that soul makes a profession of faith. Both conversion and salvation last a lifetime!

*Conversion upon conversion is true Christianity.*²²

Jacob Boehme

Conversion is a change of heart and a change of mind. We changed our minds about the Lord when we turned *away* from our sin and moved *toward* God in contrition and faith.²³ Next we turned *away* from the evil in our hearts and lives, and moved *toward* God’s ways of goodness and holiness.²⁴ And as we turned in all faith and obedience toward keeping His commandments, we were converting *away* from following our own will, and *toward* living the self-denying life.²⁵ God is continually moving us from one thing to another, from one place to another. For conversion is the *progressive* revelation of *God’s* heart, *God’s* mind, and *God’s* will to us-ward.²⁶ And now another conversion is here; one that will move the heart and mind *away* from the failed Church system—and *toward* the next age of history—the Kingdom of God’s LOVE. Therefore the Lord will again pour out His Spirit upon holy souls that have kept His commandments; who through faith and obedience demonstrate their hope in His return; and who can say with every ounce of their being—*Thy Kingdom come!*

The Kingdom Age is fast approaching. In order to prepare the world for this unprecedented event, the Lord is calling souls to this new conversion—not for salvation only, but to something greater, richer, deeper. The expectation of the Kingdom of Christ is very high among the Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers. But they are not alone in their hope for the soon return of their Lord. Interpretations of this glorious event vary among Christians. Even the cults and other religions also expect a return or reappearance of their leaders and deities. Something grand is coming! That the Kingdom is greatly anticipated in so many different ways and religions is evidence of the *world’s* great expectation.²⁷

Even now the Lord Almighty is moving His little children *away* from Spirit-less leaders and letter-guardians—who know nothing of the deep things of God; who know not how to satisfy the believer’s aching heart; and who blame the apostasy and falling away on the flock, and accuse them of having “itching ears,” when they should instead look at the leanness of their own souls! Those leaders cannot give out what they do not have! And faithful Christians need the Holy Spirit to fill them up with the perfect truth, strength, and guidance that is promised them.

Christians are homesick: they are weary travelers in a place that is not their home. Christians are lovesick: they desperately need and crave the LOVE of God to fill their empty vessels. They are famished souls that have been deprived of the True Bread and Wine: the Indwelling Spirit of the Resurrected Christ—which is that alone that can satisfy their restless hunger and thirst. Why shouldn’t they yearn for teachers that can point them to their Beloved Bridegroom? All Christians should hasten and make themselves ready—and *go out to meet Him!*²⁸

The Only Remedy

God’s desire for *all* Christians is that they grow in the faith, grace, and knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ;²⁹ that they become spiritually mature sons and daughters of the Most High,³⁰ fully able to distinguish truth from error, so that they may also teach others.³¹ But this can only be accomplished by and through the Spirit of the Indwelling Christ. And if (as the Church insists) all Christians automatically receive this coveted Promise of the Father, they would not so easily and blindly follow the perverted teachings of those *who do not have the Spirit of Christ!* Therefore it is no wonder that the Enemy has snatched away the *truth* of this Holy Spirit of Life.³²

For if and when a Christian genuinely receives the Spirit of the Resurrected Lord, he/she will at once know that the Divine Life as entered into him, as a moving, breathing, growing Birth of Life—exactly as the Lord described!³³ The Holy Spirit now becomes a Comforting Friend and Master Teacher,³⁴ to lead the soul into *all the truth* of God's Great Redemption Plan. This plan is revealed *progressively*, from age to age,³⁵ and from Christian to Christian.³⁶ Only the Spirit of Christ can produce full-grown, mature, Sons and Daughters of the Most High—not simply letter-learned—but filled with real and tangible Spiritual substance—just as the Spirit was received by the 120 Upper-Room-Waiters.³⁷ For this Spirit and Birth of the Savior in the soul is a Life that has *animation*, as an ebb and flow of Spirit with spirit; and a Breath of Life that infuses itself into every spiritual vein, and fills the soul—just as the Shekinah Glory permeated the Tabernacle in the Wilderness. This alone is what truly makes the Christian a Temple of the Holy Ghost!³⁸

Once this Spirit of the Resurrection is actually received and birthed in the soul, the Christian will have no need for the teachings of the *natural* man, as sincere and well-meaning as some may be. For all such learning will fall by the wayside.³⁹ But if this Promise is ever received on any grand scale, what will become of the leaders of the present Church system; and also the Counterfeit Kingdom? They will all be rendered *unnecessary* and *unemployed*! Therefore the *system* keeps Christians blind concerning the Holy Spirit of Life, while continuing to mass-produce Spirit-less pastors and Spirit-less teachers; also Spirit-less healers, miracle workers, and demon-slayers; discernment ministries, outreaches, and youth programs; Bible commentaries, Bible study guides, Christian self-help books; colleges, seminaries, and conventions—and now “apostles” and “prophets.” And the *only* guaranteed way to keep that system alive is to create a scheme that will prevent Christians from investigating and ultimately discovering their true heritage and inheritance!⁴⁰

A Word of Counsel

Jane Lead is no enemy to the humble soul that loves the Lord with all the heart, soul, mind, and strength: whose only desire is to love God; to please Him; and to live for Him alone. These are the Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers to whom she addressed her messages over 300 years ago. Nevertheless, Christian researchers and discernment ministries—with little to no true Spiritual insight—continue to condemn her for what she taught. That's understandable. But to condemn her for what she *didn't* teach is reprehensible. Therefore I humbly offer the same counsel that Gamaliel (himself a Pharisee) put before the letter-guardians of his day ...

Take heed what you do with the writings of Jane Lead: For if it is the work of a heretic or a crazy woman, it will come to naught. But if it is of God, it cannot be overthrown; and you will find yourself fighting against God.⁴¹

171) **Second Pentecost:** The New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) is expecting another Pentecost. Jane Lead also wrote of a Second Pentecost. But where in the Bible does it say this? And why should there be another?

Yes, Jane Lead said to expect a Second Pentecost. But her teaching is in contradistinction to the New Apostolic Reformation's expectations as to the *recipients*, the *method*, and the *mission*. NAR leaders tend to view the terms *Second Pentecost* and *Second Apostolic Age* synonymously, which makes it difficult to discern their exact meaning. Therefore this study will also use them interchangeably.

Jane Lead vs NAR

- ♦ NAR: A present massive, (second) outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the global Church.⁴²
Jane: Not a massive outpouring on the whole Church but given only to Holy Seekers.⁴³
- ♦ NAR: Began as early as 1991.⁴⁴
Jane: Began in 1696.⁴⁵
- ♦ NAR: Comes publically as a revival on a grand scale.⁴⁶
Jane: Comes privately and individually.⁴⁷
- ♦ NAR: All Christians—especially the apostles and prophets—will receive supernatural powers.⁴⁸
Jane: Will bring about the death of the Holy Seeker's inward [Body of Sin](#).⁴⁹
- ♦ NAR: Will bring about the Church's dominion over the whole world.⁵⁰
Jane: Will not bring about any ecclesiastical or political dominion.⁵¹
- ♦ NAR: Will produce a massive and worldwide end-time revival.⁵²
Jane: No end-time revival.
- ♦ NAR: Apostles and prophets will be leaders and heads of this end-time revival.⁵³
Jane: No one will be leaders or heads—as all is done hiddenly.
- ♦ NAR: Is the Holy Spirit coming to transform Christians, society and the world.⁵⁴
Jane: Is the *Spirit of Christ* coming to deliver the holy seeker from the sin-nature.⁵⁵
- ♦ NAR: Will generate a great end-time army of Christian warriors.⁵⁶
Jane: Will not generate an end-time army that will fight against man.⁵⁷
- ♦ NAR: The Second Pentecost gives Christians power.⁵⁸
Jane: The Second Pentecost makes holy souls spotless.⁵⁹

Paul's Mystery Race

In First Corinthians Paul makes it clear that upon conversion *all* Christians enter into a race.⁶⁰ But this race is not for spreading the Gospel, or to win souls, or to add numbers to their Church. Nor must they run in order to hold on to their salvation; for a Christian is *eternally* secure.⁶¹ Paul clearly stated that we are running a race *in order to win Christ!*⁶² But few Christians truly understand what that means. And the New Testament is filled with exhortations for the Christian to press on; with instructions on how the Holy Seeker and Loving Inquirer can successfully *run* and *finish* this race.⁶³

Christians are vying for a position in the Kingdom of Christ! But we do not compete with the brethren. We are competing against *our own* flesh, *our own* desires, *our own* worldliness, and everything else that elevates “self” above the Lord.⁶⁴ All these must be exposed and conquered in order to be conformed to the image of Christ.⁶⁵ Certain sins are willful disobedience; others committed in ignorance. But perhaps the worst of all is our own sense of holy righteousness by which we measure ourselves—and *everyone else!* Everything must be brought to the foot of the Cross: every desire, every ambition, and every motive. This alone is what makes the heart *perfect*, and lends toward that *holi-*

ness that God wishes to instill in ALL His children. And since the heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked⁶⁶—we often don't realize how we are displeasing to the Lord. Therefore He sends the Holy Spirit to teach us what God requires, so that we may finish our race to the end.

Holiness Not an Option

At conversion we understand that God sees us through the *imputed* righteousness of Christ.⁶⁷ But God does not see us through the *holiness* of Christ. The Bible never states that the Lord's *holiness* is imputed to the Christian. Therefore He offers to all Christians the Holy Spirit, that He may perform the work of *making us holy*. But the Holy Spirit can only make holy a soul that is *willing* to be made holy; and therefore the soul must *cooperate* with the Holy Spirit. Righteousness makes possible a right standing before God.⁶⁸ But holiness makes it possible to *see* God.⁶⁹ Tragically most Christians have *never* been taught *how* to begin that process, how to cooperate in that process, and how to complete that process: for holiness does not come without trials, temptations, hardships, and sufferings.

Again, few Christians truly understand the Holy Spirit's primary mission. Yes He is Comforter, Helper, Teacher, and Guide. But the title "Holy" does not simply represent an aspect of God's nature. It also represents His ultimate mission: to make the *Christian* holy—not in *type* or in *promise*; but as a present reality. But as we look at the Apostasy that has engulfed the Church, it would appear that the Holy Spirit has failed His mission—which of course is impossible. Therefore Christians who profess that they have Holy Spirit, are filled with the Holy Spirit, and are led by the Holy Spirit—are urged to honestly examine whether they are manifesting the *holiness* of the Lord Jesus Christ. For if not, either the Holy Spirit has failed to make them holy; or else they do not have what they profess to have received. And this realization will certainly bring about a crisis of faith. And Holy Seekers who believe that the Second Pentecost will *immediately* make them spotless are also mistaken. For as with the First Pentecost, the Second *continues* the soul's progress toward death to sin and self.

This Second measure of the Spirit will renew nature into a soft and sweet mildness, causing all contrarities of spirit to cease. (RR 1:2)

Sin, Confess, Repeat

Christians are taught that they must remain in a constant battle with sin and their flesh, right up until they leave this mortal realm. They live an endless cycle of *sin, confess, repeat* as their *acceptable* mantra. But to teach them that they can be totally set free from sin and their flesh is called *heresy*! But the God-Man came not just to forgive sin but to deliver us from the [Body of Sin](#) as well!⁷⁰ Christians who believe that they must continue sinning are in direct opposition to the Holy Scriptures that state otherwise. Pastors and teachers that insist that Christians will never be completely free from sin *in this life* are teaching contrary to the Holy Scriptures and have deceived the flock. Prideful humility accuses God of the inability to do what He said He will do.⁷¹

But this false covering is rolling away, and it is given some to believe that Sin shall be found no more, when the First and Second Baptism shall meet together... (First Message, 1M 36b)

Power for Life or Power for Death

Christians seeking a Second Pentecost in order to receive power, authority and position, or to perform miracles, healings, signs and wonders, or to prophesy or discern evil spirits have made a tragic mistake. All this only reveals the true nature of their hearts. God is not fooled; they have only fooled themselves. Do not wait another moment to seek the Lord's forgiveness! And ask for the Promise of the Father, that the Spirit of Christ may indwell you and perform the true work of cleansing your internal house. For this Second Pentecost will not raise you up. *It will bring you down!*

It is known and experienced that as we daily feed upon a crucified Christ, it devours and gradually works away the Life of Sin and all the evil effects of it. Let the wise understand and find out this mystery, and discern and taste the Lord's mystical body. (Heavenly Cloud, HC P:2)

I must solemnly profess to all such as live loosely and vainly, that they will have no part in the First Resurrection, but will be cut off from all those pleasant and unconceivable joys, and glorious and filling springs of refreshing from the presence of GOD and the Lamb, which may be tasted in this present life as the first fruits of the full harvest. (*Enochian Walks with God*, EN I:9)

He destroys that he might build; for when He is about to rear His sacred temple in us, He first totally razes that vain and pompous edifice, which human art and power had erected, and from its horrible ruins a new structure is formed, by His power only. (Madame Guyon, *Autobiography*)

The Feasts of Israel

A study of the Feasts of Israel⁷² is helpful for understanding the soul's progression from conversion to glorification.⁷³ The Christian journey begins with Passover. Once a soul demonstrates repentance toward God and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ,⁷⁴ he enters *his own* Passover, and receives forgiveness of sins through the Sacrificial Lamb: Jesus Christ. Next he enters Unleavened Bread, where both the soul and the Lord work together to *put away sin*.⁷⁵ The Christian will then progress through all the remaining feasts: Firstfruits; Pentecost, Trumpets, Day of Atonement, and Tabernacles—which are all distinct markers (stages) in the soul's journey that the Christian will ultimately pass through.⁷⁶

All *true* Christians have passed through Passover and have entered Unleavened Bread (sanctification). Successfully passing through this feast is necessary before the soul can ever enter Pentecost. Yet most Christians remain in sanctification, having never entered their own *personal* Pentecost—which alone is the *true* reception of the Holy Spirit. Here is confirmation that the Holy Spirit is not given at conversion (Passover). And unless Christians understand *why* they remain in Unleavened Bread (sanctification, wilderness journey) they will never move into Pentecost. And unless a soul has received the First Pentecost, he/she should not expect a Second. I speak of holy souls that love and faithfully follow the Lord Jesus Christ.

If a man love me [Passover, conversion], he will keep my words [Unleavened Bread, sanctification]; and my Father will love him, and we [Father and Son] will come unto him [Pentecost, the Promise of the Father, the Gift of the Spirit], and make our abode with him. (Joh 14:23)

LOVE Shed Abroad

Many of the first Christians received the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost; and many have received the same since then. Through this Holy-Spirit-Baptism, and as stated by the Apostle Paul, the believers that experience this Baptism, now have the LOVE of God as shed abroad in their hearts.⁷⁷ But is this true of all Christians? How can a Christian who has (supposedly) received the LOVE of God shed abroad in the heart, treat other Christians so unmercifully, so arrogantly, even hatefully? How can they lie, steal, cheat, and throw around abuses toward their brethren—or anyone else—if God's LOVE is truly shed abroad in their hearts? Is it not proof that the Holy Spirit is entirely absent? And is it not further confirmation of the distinct difference between Passover and Pentecost?

Christians are not to remain in Passover! Neither should they rely solely on the Baptism with the Holy Spirit—if they have ever received the baptism at all. Walking in the Spirit is a conscious, intimate, and continual living *in and through* the Spirit of Christ, in daily, moment by moment experience. But one cannot walk *in* the Spirit unless he or she has first *received* the Spirit! Christians may be walking *with Jesus*. They may be walking in the *grace* of God *through* the *Spirit of God*. But this is not the same Spirit-walk that Paul teaches. Until the Christian is *baptized* with the Spirit of Christ, he cannot *walk in the Spirit of Christ*, or *be filled with the Spirit of Christ*. This is a mystery that must be searched out by ALL true Christians at this very urgent time. ALL Christians should pray to receive this Precious Promise as a true, tangible, and living encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ!

Additional Pentecosts in Scripture

As Paul said, the First Pentecost was but the *Firstfruits* of the Holy Spirit. So why does the Church so defiantly refuse anything more that is offered to God's people? No Scripture supports this stance! The First Pentecost was given as preparation for the Second. And the early believers received *multiple* offerings of the Holy Spirit. They received baptism after baptism after baptism. They were filled, and filled, and filled again. But few Christians truly know the First Baptism let alone the Second. Those who have never been filled cannot be *refilled*. Diligent Bible study does not make one "spiritual!" Christian maturity does not make one spiritual! The baptism and filling of the Holy Spirit is that alone that makes a Christian Spiritual! Now for the Scriptures:

- ♦ In Acts Chapter 2 the first Christians, having already passed through Passover and Unleavened Bread, received their initial *shower* on the Day of Pentecost.
- ♦ Several days later those *same* Christians were filled *again*. That is, they received a Second Pentecostal outpouring. (Acts 4:31)
- ♦ The Apostle Paul was already converted when he received his first personal Pentecost (Acts 9:17), and received another outpouring in Acts 13:9.
- ♦ When Paul and Barnabas were ejected from Antioch, they were filled again. (Acts 13:52)
- ♦ Paul exhorted the Ephesians to be *filled with the Spirit*—as a *conscious* experience, to be *carefully* and *consciously* maintained. (Eph. 5:18)
- ♦ Paul instructed the Galatians to *walk in the Spirit*; as something conscious; and that by walking in the Spirit *they would not fall into sin*. (Gal. 5:16)
- ♦ Paul instructed his protégé Timothy to *stir up* the Gift that was in him. (2Tim. 1:16)

Notes on Jane's Second Personal Pentecost:

1. The Second Pentecost will be more lasting, great and wonderful than the First. (AL 27a)
2. It is a *personal* "nuptial union" with the Lord. (AL 27a)
3. This Second Pentecost will enter into holy souls that are waiting for this (Second) Pentecost, as the Apostles were waiting in Jerusalem for the First. (RR 1:2)
4. It will empower those of the First Resurrection-Life to produce births of the Holy Ghost in others—as the Apostles were able to in the First Pentecost. (AL 27a)
5. All fruitful gifts and powers of the Holy Ghost must unavoidably be brought forth. (AL 27a)
6. The miracles, healings, raising the dead, as wrought forth by the Disciples in the First Pentecost, was a Ministration peculiar for that Age. (3F 1:12, Jan. 4, 1678)
7. They were but a forerunning type of a far higher and more wonderful way than propping and keeping up the old fabric of mortality. (3F 1:13, Jan. 4, 1678)
8. The First Pentecost could never bring perfect restoration. (3F 1:13, Jan. 4, 1678)
9. The Second Pentecost will be the next shower and rushing power that will go through the mortal death. (3F 1:13, Jan. 4, 1678)
10. It is the conquering life of Jesus, who by His dying and rising, has first made the way, by reconciling the properties of nature, and bringing them to a divine harmony. (RR 1:2)
11. The Second Pentecost is the pouring out of the Spirit in fulfillment of Rev. 22:1-2. (GC 2:28)⁷⁸
12. This Second infusion of the Holy Spirit will be to holy souls that are diligently seeking and waiting for the appearance of their Bridegroom.⁷⁹

In Jane's theology the Second Pentecost has been in progress for the past 300 years.⁸⁰ It is given to specific persons, at specific times, and for a specific reason.⁸¹ Thus the Church-body as a whole is

not the intended recipients of this Second Administration. And in order to receive a Second Pentecost one must have already received the First. But most Christians have never entered Pentecost at all. *Church leaders* have misled the flock into believing that they have what they have not. Pentecost is not received by osmosis! Pentecost is not received through mental acquiescence! Pentecost is a real and tangible infusion of the Spirit of Christ into the Spirit of Man as an active, moving, and breathing presence of the Son of God inside a believer who is yet in a body of flesh!⁸²

The “Power” or the “Person” of Christ?

NAR leaders state that the Second Pentecost will bring down the “person” of Christ to indwell us, whereas the First Pentecost only brought His “power;”⁸³ and that at this Second Pentecost the *Head* (Jesus) will finally unite with His *Body* (Church) here on Earth.⁸⁴ But this not only bad theology—it is also bad physiology! How can a body be detached from its head and still function *with the head*?

In Acts Chapter 2, the Lord’s faithful followers prayed and waited for HIS return.⁸⁵ Jesus promised that HE would return.⁸⁶ Jesus is a person!⁸⁷ The Spirit of Christ is a person! They were waiting for a PERSON! His Spirit/Soul is His PERSON! A spirit without a person (soul) is considered paganism, or pantheism, or animism—*not Christianity!* And when the 120 received the Holy Spirit they received the Lord’s Spirit AND His Person! And when a Christian says the Sinner’s Prayer, he is asking a PERSON to save him. When we seek God’s help or guidance—we are addressing a PERSON!

Jesus said I WILL COME TO YOU!⁸⁸ How can He send His Spirit without Himself? The Apostle Paul said, *Christ IN YOU* [is the] *hope of Glory*;⁸⁹ and that it was no longer he (Paul) that lived—but *Christ who lived in him!*⁹⁰ And when the Apostles performed miracles, healings, and raised the dead, who actually performed them? Some say that the Apostles did by the power of the Holy Spirit. NO! It was the Lord God Himself who performed every miracle and every healing *through* those whom He was pleased to Gift in those areas.⁹¹ It was the PERSON of the Lord Jesus Christ that performed them! And to say that the Spirit of the Lord is distinct from His person turns the Holy Spirit into an *unnamed* force or energy; and is definitely not the Holy Spirit of the Bible.

Conclusion

To say that the Church doesn’t need another Pentecost is a great misunderstanding of the purpose for Pentecost in the first place. And if the First was sufficient, then why are we presently in the midst of such great Apostasy? Why so much carnality and worldliness among those who profess to have received the Holy Spirit? Why are millions of Christians failing in marriage, failing with their children, failing in business; failing with neighbors and friends? Why so much complaining and backbiting? Why are so many Christians anxious, depressed, and even suicidal? All these are *symptoms* that point to a greater and deeper problem that can never be resolved through “sound Bible exegesis.” Church leaders insist on referring souls back to the Bible when the solution is not the *letter* but the *Spirit*!

Jane’s Second Pentecost will come privately to Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers who have demonstrated their faithful obedience and love for the Lord Jesus Christ. They have wandered aimlessly in their own *inward* wilderness; suffered loss of reputation; been stripped of self-righteousness; denied their carnal desires; have been ridiculed and rejected by those they love. They have been nailed to their own *internal* cross, having followed in their Master’s sufferings.

But for the Holy Seeker there is no other way, no other path, no other hope, no other ambition, nor friend or family that can tear them away from the Love of God that is in Christ Jesus.⁹² Therefore they suffer the loss of all things; knowing who they are and where they’re headed—Not to a glorious throne but to a splintery cross. And they are in all awe and astonishment that the omnipotent Creator and Master of all worlds would ever condescend to make use of such a soul.

- 172) **Manifest Sons of God:** The NAR leaders say that an elite group of Christians will achieve a god-like status, which will give them power over sickness, disease, and even death. They will have authority over all Churches and governments, in order to usher in the Kingdom of God on Earth. Christian Researchers and Discernment Ministers are reporting that this teaching comes from Jane Lead.

Part 1: The Mystery of God

The Bible tells us that in the latter days God will shed new light and understanding of the Divine Mysteries contained in the Holy Scriptures concerning the coming Kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ.⁹³ And as His plans are *progressive*,⁹⁴ with each generation learning a little more than the one before, we can expect a tremendous unveiling of things that have long been kept hidden from time immemorial.⁹⁵ The subject is God's Great Redemption Plan which will ultimately encompass the entire world. And without question many prophesied events have yet to come to light.

God's Mysteries

God's "mysteries" are simply prophecies that remain closed (hidden) until the Lord opens the eyes of our understanding, or until they are openly revealed through outward events. But the great obstacle for God's people is that most Christians—leaders in particular—tend to reject any and all *new* revelation. Consequently (according to them) Daniel must remain sealed. The Book of Revelation must remain sealed. All remaining mysteries must stay hidden; for they can have no place in a Church that is not ready to receive the Coming King. Nevertheless new and fresh revelation will come to the Lord's faithful ones as promised by the Revealer of these Divine Mysteries:

For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was anything kept secret, but that it should come abroad... Fear them not [doubters, mockers, letter-guardians] therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known. (Mar. 4:22; Mat 10:26)

Mysteries Unsealed

But who will understand the mysteries that Daniel was commanded to seal up?⁹⁶ And to whom will the Lord be pleased to dispense the hidden Messages of the Seven Thunders that the Apostle John was forbidden to write down?⁹⁷ Is it too bold to say that the Holy Scriptures remain incomplete until all mysteries are fully unsealed? And for those who say that everything is already fulfilled in Jesus misunderstand the difference between eternity past and the present reality; and between promises given and promises fulfilled. And while Christ's resurrection accomplished our resurrection *from before all time*, yet the outward fulfillment of that promise has not yet happened. This is still another mystery that cannot be fully understood—much less apprehended—until the Lord brings it to pass.

Is it finished?

Contrary to what most Christians believe, all was not accomplished at the Cross. When Jesus said "It is finished," He was speaking as the Sacrificial Offering for the sins of the world. The Cross made forgiveness possible. Yet Passover only *opened the way* for *everything* to return to its original glory. Only the indwelling Spirit of Christ-resurrected makes regeneration possible. And only the regeneration can ultimately destroy the sin in our members. For resurrection is the *sign* and *evidence* that sin has been conquered!⁹⁸ For as the Apostle Paul stated, *If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.*⁹⁹ After the Lord's resurrection, and after He ascended, and after He offered His victorious blood on the Heavenly Altar—He came down as the Spirit of Regeneration, that would destroy sin *in our flesh*, and perform our own *resurrection* and *ascension*. Thereby is concluded that God's *full and complete* Redemption-Plan could not have been finished at the Cross!

The Mystery of His Will

Much more remains to be accomplished by the Resurrection-Spirit of Christ. For the fulfillment of the “Mystery of all Mysteries,” a.k.a. the *Mystery of God*, and, *Mystery of His Will*, is yet future:

But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the Mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets. (Rev 10:7)

Again this cannot mean the Cross: for the John wrote this some 60 years *after* Jesus died on Calvary. And the message of the *Apocalypse* concerns *the Lord's Day*, or, *the Day of the Lord*, which has not yet happened. Therefore all the mysteries in the Bible, and in the heavens, and on the earth and under earth, and in the sea—are all included in the Great Mystery of God—which fulfillment is yet future! And to forbid the unveiling under the false notion that *no new revelation is to be given to the Church* only further confirms that the Holy Spirit—who alone is able to unravel these mysteries—is sorely missing in the Church!¹⁰⁰ Christians are *robbed* of any further unveiling of the God's Great Redemption-Plan simply because their Spirit-less leaders and letter-guardians *insist* that the Bible remains sealed! And they reject *any* and *all* new revelation from the God and Creator of all worlds.

How then do they explain the *Messages of the Seven Thunders* (Rev. 10:4)? Or the Mystery of God itself (Rev. 10:7)? Can they tell us what Jesus wrote in the ground with His finger (John 8:6)? What about the nine missing Days of the Omer? *Let them declare it if they have understanding!*¹⁰¹ Therefore can it not be successfully argued that the Bible is not complete until all mysteries are unsealed? And to loosely state that “everything was revealed and accomplished through Christ”—isn't that considered cheating? For it represents a failure of Christian leaders to do their homework. Those who teach others must first learn themselves: For God wants to show His people just *when* and *how* the Lord Jesus Christ will accomplish these things.

But who is qualified to receive God's mysteries? And who will diligently look into His secrets? And who will be the *new* Daniels, that fall on their faces and plead over the sins of their people?¹⁰² Pastors? Teachers? “Apostles?” “Prophets?” The Scriptures are clear: God is pleased to open up His secrets to faithful, obedient, and *perfect* followers of the Lord Jesus Christ:

He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God... If our heart condemn us not, *then* have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight... For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart is perfect toward him.¹⁰³

Therefore disobedient Christians are disqualified.¹⁰⁴ Carnal and worldly Christians are disqualified!¹⁰⁵ Skeptics and mockers of these Divine Mysteries can never reach the deep things of God!¹⁰⁶ And when a 46-year-old Englishwoman, who lived a holy life; who upon her widowhood pledged herself as a Bride to the Lord Jesus Christ alone;¹⁰⁷ who was visited with direct and divine communications from the Triune God-Head;¹⁰⁸ who received new and fresh revelations that had not yet been disclosed; who kept a record of them, and tucked them away in her heart; and who after many years received an express command from the Lord to make them public—*this is the woman they* [the disobedient, carnal, and worldly skeptics and mockers] *call a heretic and a blasphemer!*¹⁰⁹

But Jane's messages are only a *partial* revealing of what is yet to happen in these last days. So how are they to be received? And who will interpret them? Why did God give the Gift of Prophecy to the Church if Christians are not allowed to exercise that Gift?¹¹⁰ And why did Paul instruct the Church to allow the prophets to speak and for another to *judge* if no new revelation is to be expected or accepted?¹¹¹ And why do Church leaders warn against receiving anything other than the “completed” canon of Scripture? Is this not the Enemy's conspiracy to keep the mysteries of God's Divine Plan out of the hands of God's people? Church leaders rightly warn against the NAR. But another conspiracy at play, hidden within the other: For while the NAR proclaims “A new thing has arrived,” the Church says “If it's new it isn't true.” Both are wrong. And both are working together though they realize it not.

The New Korahites

In Numbers Chapter 16 is a tragic example of evil men taking for themselves something they were not given. During the Wilderness Journey, Korah (a Levite), Dathan and Abiram (Reubenites), jealous over the power and authority that was given to Moses and Aaron, claimed for themselves that which was designated for someone else. Moses and Aaron were God's Chosen Ones. Yet the Korahite-company demanded that God regard them as "chosen" as well. So they, along with 250 other tribal leaders, stirred up a spirit of rebellion in God's people; and they all stood up against God and His Elected Ones.

Those Korahites did not attempt to prove themselves acceptable to God in the portion they had already received. Instead they wanted power and prestige. They wanted to be priests of the Most High that could handle the *sacred things* of the Lord.¹¹² Not content with their own portion, they *demand-ed* that which was given to someone else! Selfishness, covetousness, and unruly pride was the fruit of their ambitions. And they magnified themselves; and the people also magnified them. But in the end they were all brought down. Only a few remained faithful to God, Moses, and Aaron.

Today's NAR leaders are the new Korahites! They call themselves the Firstborn, the Manifest Sons of God, the Sonship Company, the Corporate Christ, Joel's Army, and many other names. And they preach openly and loudly "Are we not equal to the Lord Jesus Christ? Are we not spiritual? Are we not the appointed leaders and promoters of something new? Do we not collect millions for Christ's Kingdom? Are we not brilliant marketers? Do we not write bestselling books, hold massive assemblies and sold-out concerts?" These are the merchants of the Earth that have become fat through their marketing schemes and branding devices. They have manipulated God's people. And the souls they deceive and accumulate have become their contraband:

And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more: The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble, And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, AND SOULS OF MEN. (Rev 18:11-13)

And like their forefather Korah, they have taken upon themselves positions that do not belong to them. They ignore that admonition: *He that is faithful in little is faithful in much*. And their *expectation* of Manifest Sonship, Joel's Army, the Corporate Christ, and the Man-Child is their Golden Calf!¹¹³ But all will come to naught: For pride, covetousness—and *misleading God's people*—will be their ruin.¹¹⁴

But these new Korahites aren't the only ones that are guilty of desiring to handle that which is not assigned to them. Every example of an evangelist, or pastor, or teacher who has not the Spirit of Christ, and is magnified by the people—and *allow themselves to be magnified*—is a Korahite! And every example of a pastor, who has not the Spirit of Christ, and is raised up to even have the unmerited rule over the people—is a Korahite! And every teacher who has not the Spirit of Christ, and has failed to properly nourish the Church—and yet is admired and magnified by the people—and dares to allow this admiration—is a Korahite! And every Church leader who has been brought down through unspeakable scandal is a Korahite! And like the evil King Saul, they will all be brought down when the True David's make their appearance.
